- 4. Why did it take 40 years for the Israelites to inherit the Promised Land? What does this reveal to you about God and human beings?**
- 5. Jesus says that we all must receive the kingdom of God like a little child in order to enter it (Mark 10:15). In your opinion, how can that be done? What would that look like or be like?**
- 6. In your own words, explain why it would be easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle than for a rich person to enter the kingdom of God?**
- 7. What lesson does Jesus want us to learn from the example of the withered fig tree? Why?**
- 8. Why is Jesus impressed with the widow's offering of two copper coins? What can we learn from the widow's example that we can apply to our own life?**
