

## **STUDY GUIDE QUESTIONS – WEEK 21**

- 1. Much of the information we find in 1 and 2 Samuel and 1 and 2 Kings is repeated in 1 and 2 Chronicles. Why? In your opinion, what is the purpose of having these two books in the biblical canon?**
- 2. The House or Temple of God is built by Solomon, not David. Why?**
- 3. What was the purpose of worship for David? Why? What were the central tenants of worship that David inaugurated amongst the people of Israel (see 1 Chronicles 16)?**
- 4. Why was God so angered by the census David ordered in 1 Chronicles 21? What did the census symbolize? What were the ramifications of this census on Israel?**
- 5. Why is a woman accused of adultery brought before Jesus in John 8? How does Jesus defend the woman? What does this story teach us about religious law and practice?**
- 6. What does Jesus mean when he says, “you will know the truth and the truth will set you free (John 8:32)?” What truth is Jesus talking about? Who will be set free and from what?**
- 7. Who is actually revealed as being “blind” in John 9? What is the cause of their blindness according to Jesus?**
- 8. In John 10, Jesus refers to himself as the “Good Shepherd.” Why? What does that title imply about Jesus? Who are the sheep? Where is Jesus leading them?**
