- 1. How does God respond to Job's charges? What does God say to him? How do you interpret God's response to Job? In your opinion, did God answer Job's questions? Why or why not? Were any of your questions answered by God's response to Job?**
- 2. How does Job respond to God? Why? What happens to Job following his encounter with God? What happens to Job's friends?**
- 3. What genre of literature are the Psalms? Who wrote most of the Psalms? Why do you think they were included in the Bible?**
- 4. What is the difference in tone between Psalm 9 and Psalm 13? Why? What might have been happening to the Psalmist when he wrote Psalm 9? What might have been happening when he wrote Psalm 13?**
- 5. Who is Lydia? What is significant about her encounter with Paul? Why?**
- 6. What is the cost of discipleship for Paul, Silas, and Timothy in places like Macedonia, Thessalonica, and Beroea? Why do they endure it? What joy do they get from discipleship?**
- 7. Why is Paul so upset with the people of Athens? Why is he allowed to preach his message? How is his message received? Who hears and believes his message in Athens? What does that say about God's Word?**
- 8. What is the difference between John's baptism and that of the Holy Spirit? Why did Paul feel it was important for the disciples in Ephesus to be baptized in the Spirit?**
