- 1. How would you define and describe what the Psalmist refers to as God’s “steadfast love?” Where does the Psalmist see this love at work? Have you seen evidence of this love in your own life? If so, where and when?**
- 2. According to Psalm 112, what does it mean to be righteous? What are the characteristics of righteousness?**
- 3. Why is the Exodus such a significant event for the Psalmist? What does that event symbolize theologically?**
- 4. What does Paul mean when he says, “The wisdom of this world is foolishness with God?” (1 Cor 3:18) What theological point is Paul trying to make?**
- 5. What does Paul say is defiling the Corinthian church in 1 Corinthians 5? How does Paul suggest the church resolve this problem? Do you agree with Paul’s resolution? Why or why not?**
- 6. According to Paul, how are we to treat our bodies? Why?**
- 7. According to Paul, what are the pros and cons of marriage? What are the pros and cons of being single?**
- 8. How does Paul answer the Corinthian’s question about eating food sacrificed to idols? Should they eat it or not? Why? Can you think of a similar question that people in the church today might ask regarding proper Christian etiquette that would elicit the same response from Paul?**
