- 5. How does Paul define the power and purpose of scripture in 2 Timothy 3? Why do we continue to read scripture today?**
- 6. What does Paul instruct Titus to do in Crete? What work does Paul feel he has left "half-done"? What work does he want Titus to complete? Why?**
- 7. Who is Philemon? Who is Onesimus? Why did Paul write a letter to Philemon? What does he want him to do? Why?**
- 8. Who is Paul describing in Hebrews 1? Why do you think Paul would begin a letter in such a way? Who is Paul trying to reach with this letter? Why?**
