- 1. Who are the false prophets that God wants Ezekiel to preach against in Chapter 13? What are they doing? Why have they incurred God’s wrath?**
- 2. What promise does God make to the people of Israel in Ezekiel 18? What are the theological implications of this promise? Does this promise affect our lives today? Why or why not?**
- 3. Who will be the true “remnant” of Israel that will return from exile? How will they be known? How will God be known through them?**
- 4. Who are Oholah and Oholibah? What is their story? Why does Ezekiel tell their story to the people of Israel? What does he want them to learn?**
- 5. What is faith? What are works? According to James, what is faith without works? Why?**
- 6. What is “real religion” or “real faith,” according to James? What does it require? What is false religion or false faith?**
- 7. What power do our words possess? Why does James warn his readers to be cautious when opening their mouths?**
- 8. In James’ opinion, what is the difference between living foolishly and living wisely? How can we live wisely today?**
- 9. What does it mean to be a “suffering servant?” Why does Peter believe all Christians should serve in this way? Do you agree or disagree with Peter? Why or why not?**
