(The choir will sing the first and last verse and the congregation will join them in singing the middle two verses. The lyrics for those verses will be on the screen.)

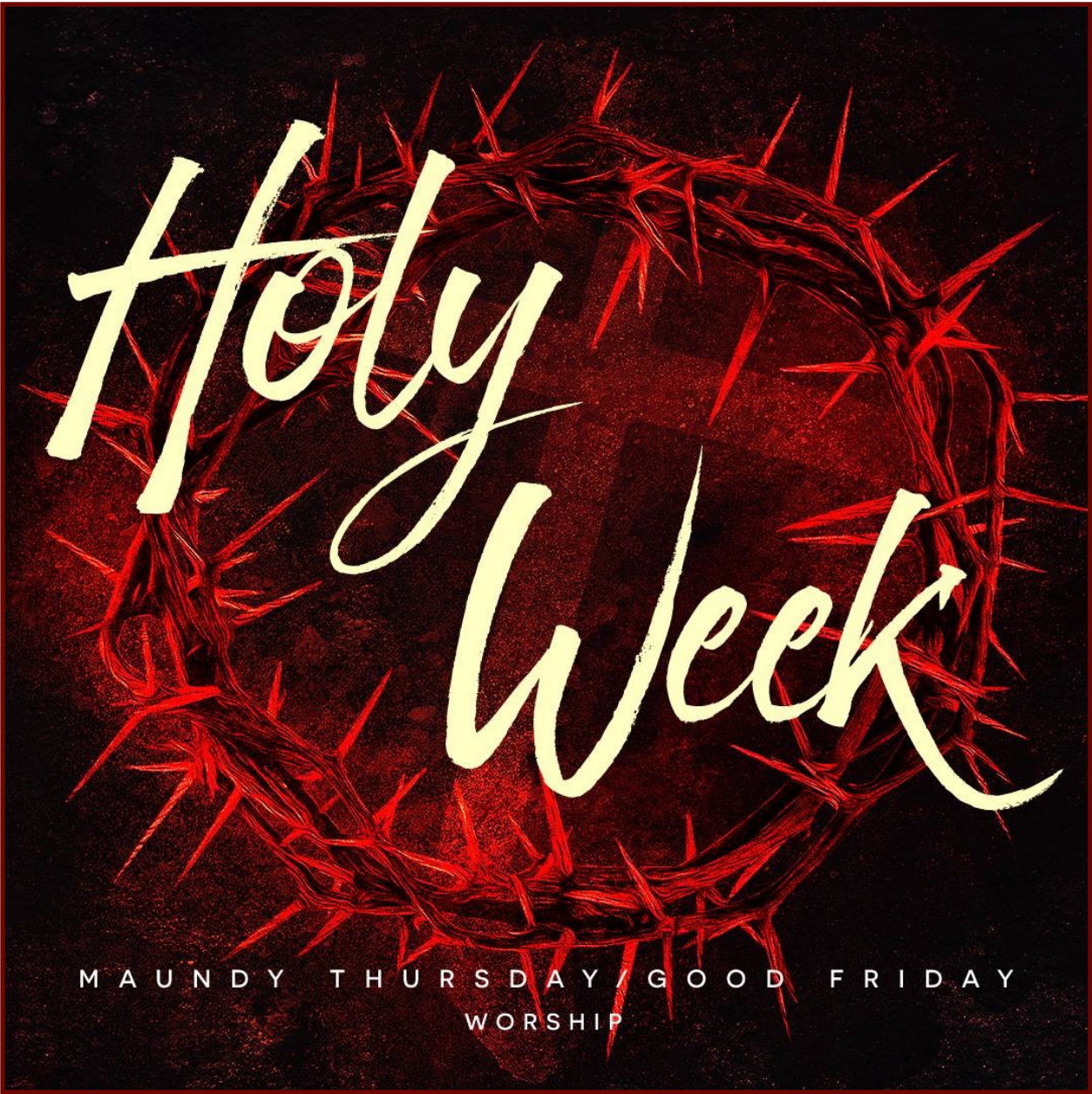
*Departure

Prayer of Confession
